The B.C. National Theatre School Festival Scholarship acknowledges and honours exceptional talent and commitment to theatre by students participating in the B.C. National Theatre School Festival.

DESCRIPTION

- A scholarship will be awarded to a British Columbia secondary school student who:

 -will be graduating by the end of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.
 - -will be entering a college or university program which will provide training for a career in the theatre arts or drama/theatre education in the fall following the spring in which they are eligible to apply.
 - -has participated in the 2019 B.C. National Theatre School Festival as a performing or non-performing delegate in the year of the application.
 - -has demonstrated exceptional talent in and commitment to drama/theatre.
- 2. The scholarship provides financial assistance towards tuition fees for the program in which the recipient enrolls.
- 3. A minimum of one \$1000 scholarship will be awarded in the 2019 year, given in one payment when the selected recipient provides proof of post-secondary enrollment to: Sharon Conrad at theatre.garden@yahoo.ca

- 2. One complete application package MUST be submitted ELECTRONICALLY NO LATER than 12:00 p.m. noon on MON. APR. 29, 2019 to Sharon Conrad at theatre.garden@yahoo.ca
- 3. The scholarship recipient will be chosen by a panel of professional theatre artists and educators. Applicants will be given an opportunity to meet with the panel and discuss their educational and career plans at the B.C National Theatre School Festival on either May 3 or 4, 2018 at the Festival venue.
- 4. The scholarship recipient will be announced on the final evening of the B.C. National Theatre School Festival on Sat. May 4, 2019.
